

Joplin Schools Hall of Fame Nomination Packet

The Joplin Schools Foundation seeks distinguished alumni who graduated from one of Joplin's four public high schools (Joplin High School, Lincoln School, Memorial High School, or Parkwood High School). Nominees need not currently reside in the Joplin School District, nor did academic, career or community achievements need to occur in the Joplin area. Nominees may be honored posthumously. All nominees must have graduated at least 25 years prior to their nomination.

Please note - Current Joplin Schools Foundation members, Nominating and Selection Committee Members, Members of the Joplin Schools Board of Education, or current Joplin Schools employees are not eligible for the Alumni Hall of Fame recognition. Nominees must not have been employed (i.e., not provided any services for compensation) by the district for at least three years prior to their nomination.

Each application must include:

- The enclosed completed form which will allow you to give an extensive explanation detailing
 why the nominee deserves recognition as a Hall of Fame member. Please describe their
 accomplishments, awards, and/or contributions to their field of expertise and to their
 community, taking care to emphasize a lifetime of achievement. A resume may be submitted.
- Two to four Letters of Support are recommended, sharing how the nominee is a role model who demonstrates leadership, character, and dedication to their chosen profession, life pursuits and/or commitment to Joplin Schools.

Nominations may be submitted electronically or by postal service year-round.

A May 1st cutoff date will be used for entrance into a current year's consideration.
